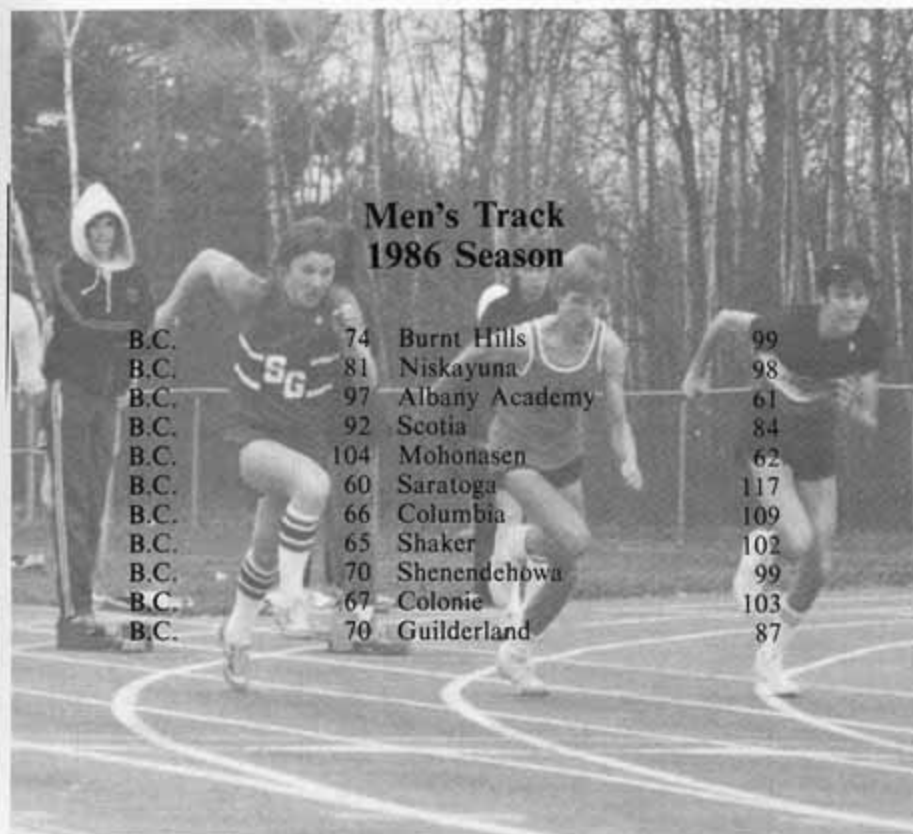
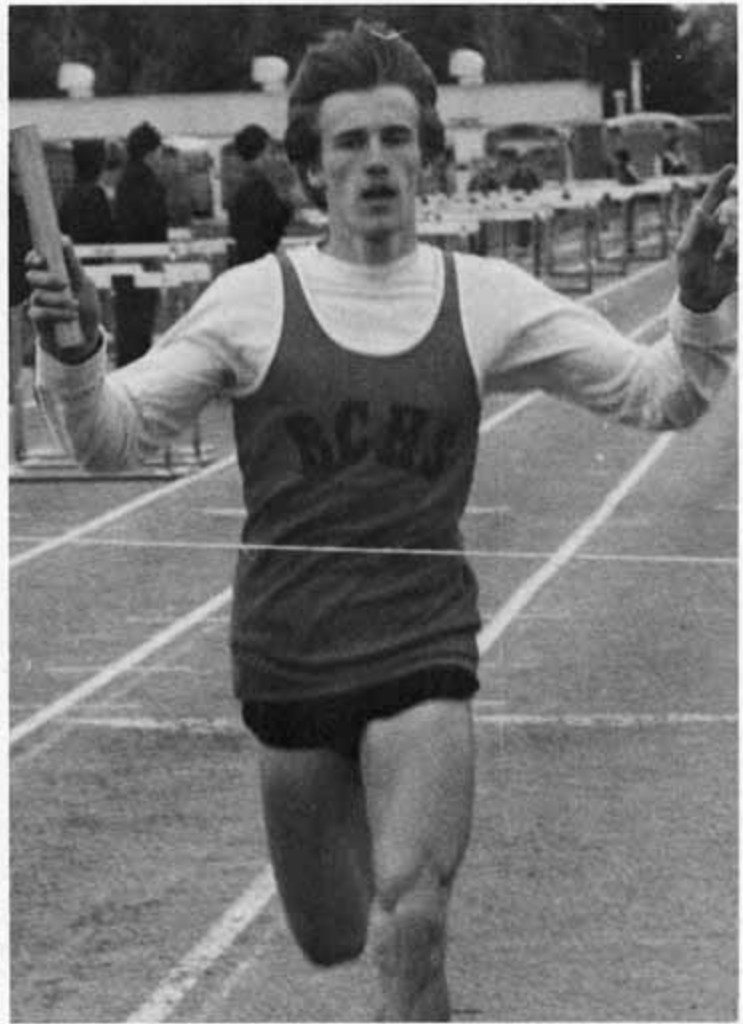


Mark LeBeau Captures State 800M Title For B.C.!

Though their record was a mere three wins and eight losses, the Bethlehem men's Varsity track team's 1986 season could be considered a success, because many new school records were set.

A tremendous asset to the team was Mark LeBeau, a transfer from Shaker High. He was the New York State 800 meter champion in a school record time of 1:53.3. His respectable times of 23.7 and 15.2 seconds in the 200 meter dash and 100 meter high hurdles were also new school records.

The 3200 meter relay team of Ian Berry, Pete Winkler, Greg Dobbert and Mark LeBeau ran to the Section II Class A championship in a time of 8:12.5, another school record. Bob Colquhoun also garnered a B.C. record with his speedy 11.5 clocking in the 100 meter dash. Team captains were Dobbert, Colquhoun, LeBeau, Winkler, and long jumper-hurdler Brian McGarrahan.
