

Carey And Ross Reach State Meet

Five School Records Fall In '86 Season

School records were in abundance for the womens' varsity track team last spring. There were five in all, including two in the 3200 and 1600-meter relays. Senior Jen Hammer, junior Anne Carey, junior Heather Wolfe, and Jen's eighth-grade sibling Julie ran a 9:42.4 en route to a BC record in the 3200-meter relay. The two Hammers, along with Carey and senior Cindi Ferrari also turned in a school record performance. Theirs came in the 1600-meter relay in a time of 4:19.2. Sophomore Connie Pogue sprinted to personal bests of 12.6 and 26.8 in the 100 and 200-meter dashes, and classmate Kristin Cooke leaped 31' 8" in the triple jump. All three performances are new Bethlehem records. The Eagles placed fifth in the Class A Section II Championships, but for Carey and sophomore Kelly Ross, the season did not end there. The two competed in the State Meet in Baldwinsville, where Carey placed fourth in the 400-meter hurdles in a time of 64.0 seconds. Ross, who owns the school high jump record of 5' 7", which she set in 1985, jumped 5' 5" in the States. Team captains were Jen Hammer, Carey, Ferrari, Melissa Coccozza, and Andrea Armstrong.
