The B.C. Men's Varsity Cross Country squad enjoyed its most successful season in 17 years this past fall. The team compiled a 10-1 record, good enough for its second consecutive Suburban Council Championship.

The squad took team titles at the Gloversville, Johnstown, Albany County and Suburban Council Invitationals. The BC men were ranked as high as 22nd in the state and were denied what would have been their first appearance in the Cross Country State Meet since 1969 by a disappointing 4th at Sectionals.

Senior Pete Winkler and Junior Tom Nyilis led the men. Winkler took 5th at Suburbans and 11th at the Grout. Nyilis won Johnstown and took 6th at the Albany County meet. Junior Brendan Kearse was 6th at Gloversville and 12th at Suburbans, while classmate Craig Isenberg was 8th at Albany County and 10th at Gloversville. Senior Captain David DeCecco finished 13th at Albany County and enjoyed a season of great improvement. Winkler, Kearse, and Nyilis were named League All-Stars.
