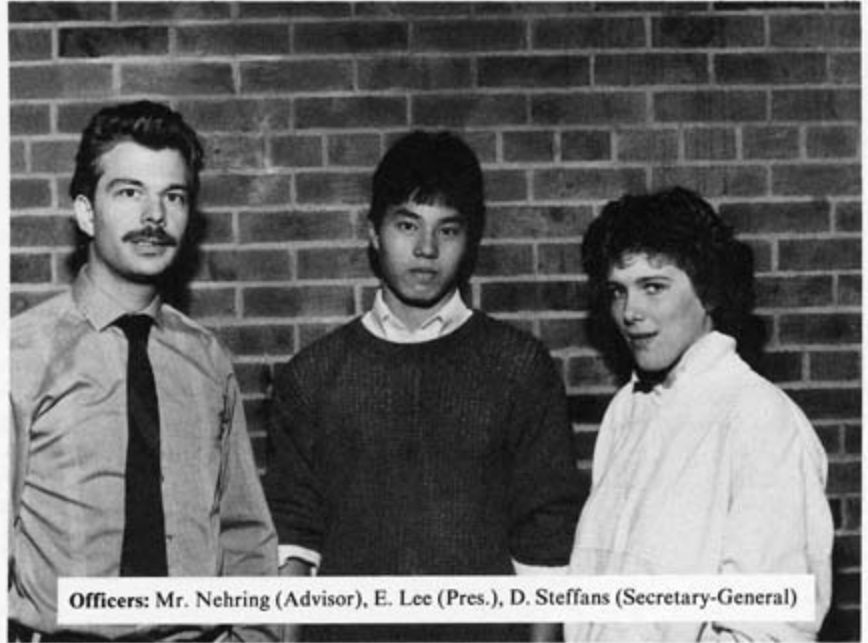


Model U.N.
